On Friday the Supreme Court confirmed the ATF's ban on bump stocks was unlawful and unconstitutional. It was a straightforward case of statutory interpretation and this is a win for the American people. I personally want to thank my customers, supporters, and the Gun Owners of America for stepping up to protect the Nation. I am proud of the role I played and thankful for the work of the attorneys.

Inventing the bump stock and building my company allowed me, a disabled veteran from a small town in West Texas, to take my family out of poverty and create a life for my children I never imagined. I was able to employ dozens of friends, family, and veterans in Moran, Texas. We were one of the last employers in a decaying town. After a madmen murdered 60 Americans and injured countless others in Las Vegas, I made the difficult decision to shut down my company and close our doors. The ATF ban came later, and I knew it was not legal.

While the Court's ruling on Friday is a positive development for the manufacture and sale of bump stocks, and has been long awaited, I have decided that it is time to hand the reins to someone else. I have retired to a quiet ranch in Tennessee with my family that I adore. As it stands, I hold all intellectual property rights for the manufacture of bump stocks.
